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# Welcome to this latest edition of Spotlight

It is very pleasing to report another successful year for the Emerson Group, with solid growth in profits from all areas of the business, a strengthened balance sheet and increase in shareholder value.

Despite living in unprecedented times, where political and economic uncertainty is increasingly becoming the norm, the environment appears to have had minimal impact on overall activity and investment levels. Businesses and consumers are cautious, but willing to look beyond the uncertainty and the underlying economic indicators and proceed accordingly.

Visitor interest has continued to successfully convert into sales for our UK Residential Division, helped by the extended support of the Government's Help to Buy scheme and the continued affordability of consumer mortgages and low interest rates. We continue to actively replenish our landbank and I am pleased with the future pipeline of land and confident that it will sustain profit growth, particularly in the smaller regions.

Despite commercial property transactions falling in the UK, our UK Commercial Division added four new properties to the portfolio that will offer value growth in the future.

With the exception of the short term reaction to Brexit, property values have remained relatively stable so it is pleasing to report that the value of our UK portfolio has increased by £17m which is down to the Group's philosophy on quality property management, active tenant communication and quality upgrade and refurbishment where appropriate.

Our International Division USA has continued to perform well. We have now established Jones Homes USA as a major housebuilder capable of delivering returns on our considerable landbank. All developments in the USA are progressing well, and we continue to work collaboratively to mutual benefit with our joint venture partners. Similarly, in Portugal, the Algarve is showing a modest, but steady improvement and continues to offer a safe haven for holidaymakers, golfers and retirees. Rental incomes have increased at our resorts, along with associated activities including golf, spa and restaurant bookings.

All of this could not happen without the continued commitment of our exceptional team, and I am grateful to them for their ongoing support and dedication to the business. Through uncertain times and varying market

conditions, the directors, managers and staff continue to show their loyalty and I would like to thank them for the contribution they have made.

Overall, the Group remains conservatively managed and has never been financially stronger. We will continue to pursue the strategy set out in the Strategic Report and focus on our key strengths of providing quality products and services to customers. We are perfectly placed to capitalise on current favourable trading conditions and will continue to drive the business forward and invest for the long term wellbeing of our shareholders.


